[1] Having applied the relevant appellate standard of review emanating from **Watt (or Thomas) v Thomas** [1947] 1 All ER 582 and **Rayon Sinclair v Edwin Bromfield** [2016] JMCA Civ 7, we found nothing in the learned Parish Court Judge's decision to justify the interference of this court. There is no basis in law on which it can be said that her judgment should be disturbed.
